Pump and dump

Characteristics of play:

No news or low key news:

-usually A grade pumps are on no news or very low key news that has no substential short term impact on performance of company, usually weird unusual news

Chat rooms:

-often chat rooms are the one jumping on the plays once it starts to move beyond 10% on a day green which eventually ends with profit taking and full collapse as buyers liquidate by end of the day

Scanner time:

-Actively scan for those play from 9:40 to 10:00 since thats where most of them are, rescan every 5 min in TC2000, otherwise you will miss them, or just use scan service like Tradeldeas.

-use % gainer scan to spot them

No gap:

-A grade plays will be on no gap ahead and also very low key or no news at all, be aggressive on those and do not be too tight on SLs, most of those will fade all the way till end of day.

Full fade:

-usually pumps fade all the way in 1st day which makes them great play for quickly in and out

History of fades:

-check if it has history of aggressive 1 day fades (at least 3) if it has then it fits even more into A grade

Volume:

-very important, A grade pumps never reach above 100K volume per M1 candle, they stay bellow whole time
