<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Open the text file in your favorite editor. 2. This is a full-featured template that is a good starting position for a trading plan. The template contains: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Plan management rules to control profit and loss for the overall plan b. Trailing stops c. Automatic order stop and take profit settings from ATR calculations d. Automatic order sizing from risk management settings (preset at 1% of available margin). 3. To use this plan simply replace the highlighted rules (retaining the R:01, and R:02,) with alternate qualifiers. Use the accompanying Samples guide as a starting place. 4. Alternatively, you can delete this text and create or copy a new trading plan. 5. Save changes 	
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. To force fxRulesEngine to read your new plan, switch timeframes between 5 minutes and 1 minute, for example. 	
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. So how well did it go? You can log fxRulesEngine by adjusting logging in Properties as well as exporting the results to a CSV text file that can be imported into Excel. 2. The results are stored in the fxrules folder.
