For those who value privacy and want to control their assets, DEXs are a solid option. While you can't make direct bank transfers, you can trade SHIB for stablecoins or other tokens and later send them to a CEX to cash out. In general, decentralized exchanges provide more privacy but require extra effort.

A Step-By-Step Guide On How To Withdraw Shiba Inu

With the withdrawal options in mind, we can now detail the steps you should follow. Here's how to transfer Shiba Inu to your bank account:

- Select a Trusted Exchange
- Send SHIB Tokens to the Exchange Wallet
- Change Shiba Inu to Fiat
- Fill in Your Banking Details
- Request a Withdrawal
- Confirm

- Regulations: Depending on your country, cryptocurrency withdrawals might incur taxes, so it's essential to follow local tax laws and reporting requirements for large sums.

What Are Shiba Inu Withdrawal Fees?

Shiba Inu withdrawal fees are the costs of changing SHIB tokens into fiat and sending them to your bank. Fee structures vary across platforms: some apply a flat fee, while others calculate fees as a percentage of the withdrawal amount or according to the selected payment method. The Shiba Inu withdrawal fee ranges from \$0.75 to around \$10.

How To Withdraw Shiba Inu From Trust Wallet?

Trust Wallet does not support direct bank withdrawals. To withdraw Shiba Inu from Trust Wallet, take the following steps:

- Launch Trust Wallet
- Choose SHIB from Your Assets
- Send Shiba Inu to a Reliable Exchange Wallet
- Trade It for Fiat
- Withdraw Coins from the Selected Exchange

Does Phantom Wallet Support Shiba Inu?

At present, Phantom Wallet is dedicated to assets on the Solana blockchain and does not support Shiba Inu. Therefore, you'll need to resort to a different exchange and comply with its withdrawal steps to get your money into your bank.

How To Withdraw Shiba Inu From Binance?

It's relatively simple to withdraw SHIB from Binance. Here's how you do it:

- Log in to Binance
- Go to "Wallet" and click on "Fiat and Spot"
- Find SHIB and click "Withdraw"
- Paste Your Banking Details
- Submit

How To Withdraw Shiba Inu From Coinbase?

You can seamlessly transfer your Shiba Inu to your bank account using Coinbase. Just take these actions:

- Access Coinbase Account

- Select SHIB and Press “Sell”
- Pick the Fiat Option

- Confirm
